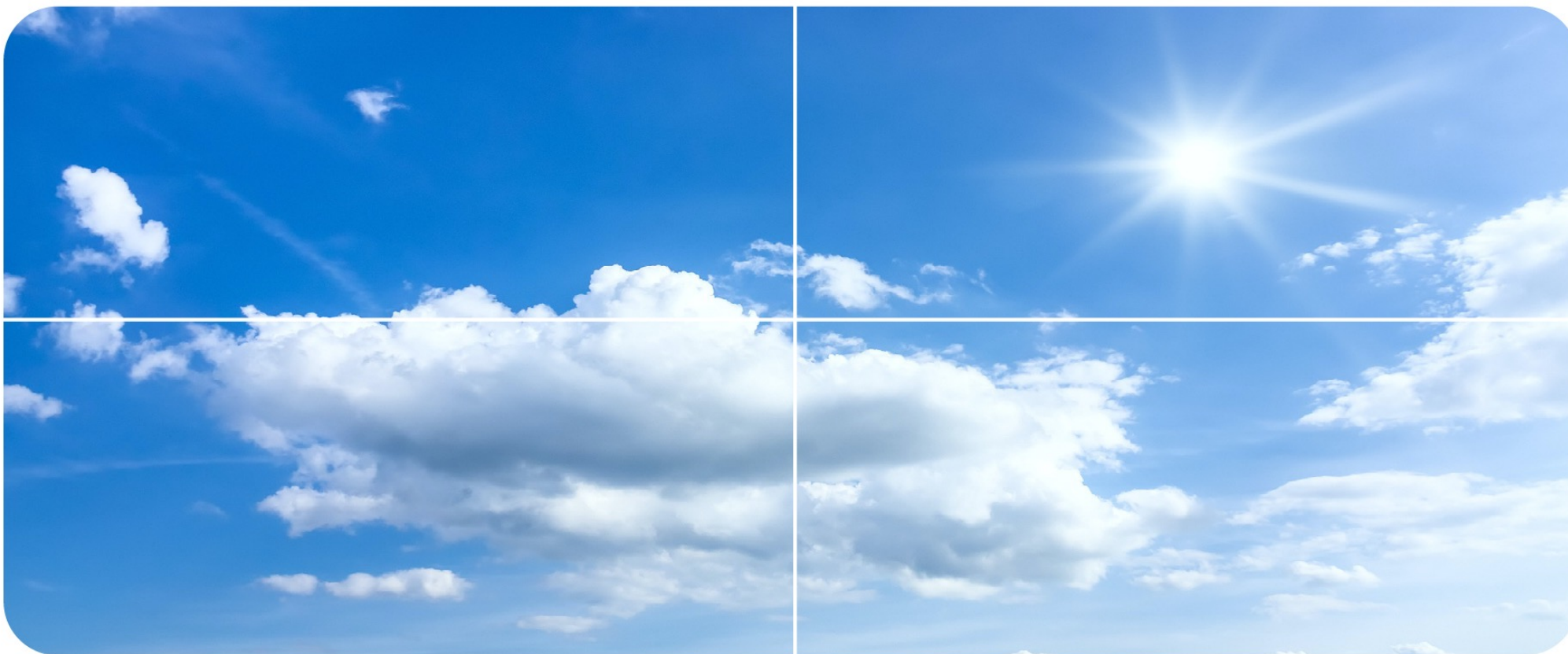

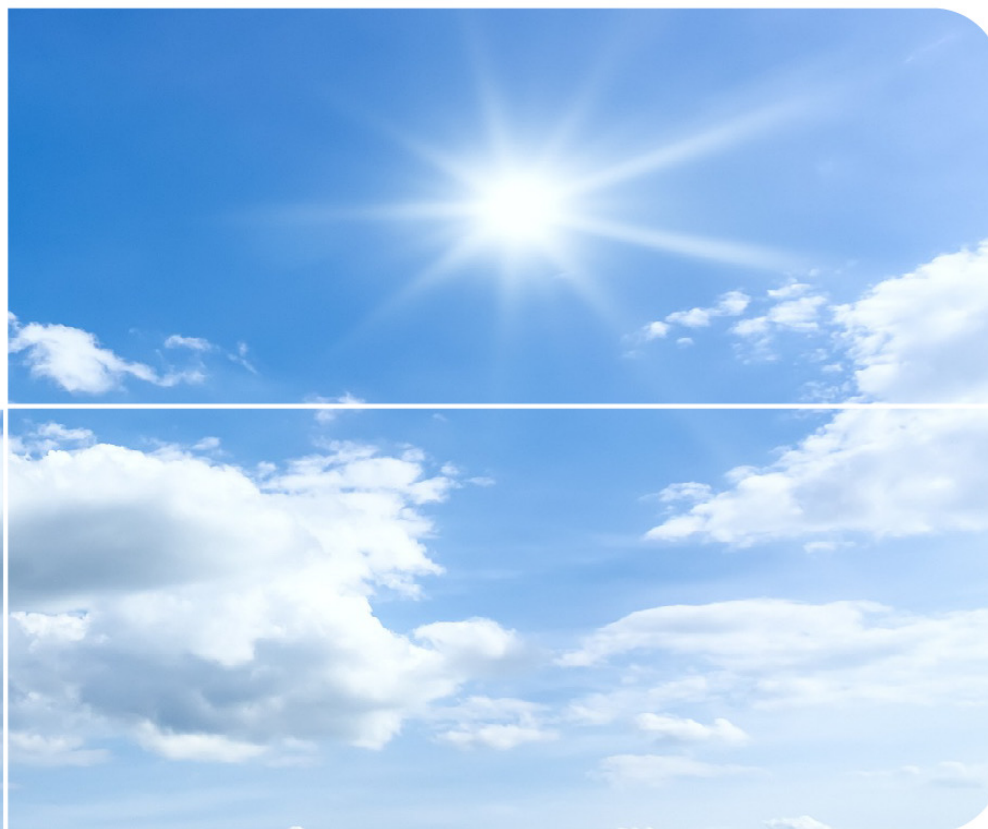

EU for Better Environment - Project Objective, Purpose and Implementation Period

Overall objective:

Increased alignment with the EU environmental *acquis*, through improved strategic and institutional framework.

Purpose:

To achieve an enhanced strategic policy, legal and institutional environmental framework for selected priority directives in **horizontal, air and chemicals sectors**.

Project Implementation Period:

33 months (January 2019 – October 2021)



What is the project about?

Support to the implementation of the National Environmental Approximation Strategy (NEAS) and to the upcoming EU negotiation process in three different sectors of the Chapter 27: Environment and Climate Change:

- Ambient Air Quality
- Chemicals
- Horizontal (INSPIRE)

by providing technical assistance to the Ministry of Environmental Protection and to other beneficiaries/stakeholders with the preparation of strategic, planning and programming documents, needed for the EU approximation and negotiation process.

Results to be achieved

Result 1: Approximation status assessed (1)

Assessment of the approximation status related to EU air, chemical and horizontal acquis for the following:

- Ambient Air Quality
 - **AAQ** - Directive 2008/50/EC including 4th Daughter Directive (2004/107/EC);
 - **NEC** - Directive (EU) 2016/2284;
 - **Sulphur in fuels** - Directive (EU) 2016/802;
 - **Petrol and diesel fuels quality** - Directive 98/70/EC;
 - **VOC I and VOC II** - Directive 94/63/EC and Directive 2009/126/EC).
- Chemicals
 - **REACH** - Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006;
 - **BPR** - Biocidal Products Regulation (EU) No.528/2012;
- Horizontal
 - **INSPIRE** - Directive 2007/2/EC



Results to be achieved

Result 1: Approximation status assessed (2)

- **Transposition Status Assessment**
 - Screening of the legal framework
 - Review and updating of ToCs
 - Compliance Check
- **Administrative and Institutional Assessment**
 - Review and updating of IQs
 - Overview and analysis of existing Serbian administrative system and institutional organization
 - Assessment of the tasks laid down by the EU directives and regulations
 - Assessment of the administrative and institutional capacity
 - Description of the tasks and duties of the identified organisation units
- **Implementation and Enforcement Status Assessment**

Outputs:

- **Development of the Approximation Status Report**
- **Presentation of the Approximation Status Report – three events**



Results to be achieved (2)

Result 2: Implementation plans prepared

Strengthened capacities and capabilities of the MEP (air and chemicals management) and of the Republic Geodetic Authority (INSPIRE) for planning of implementation of EU requirements for selected directives/ regulations.

Developing planning documents through a transparent and inclusive process.

Outputs:

- **Programme of Air Protection (PAP) of the Republic of Serbia with Action plan;**
- **Eight Directive/ Regulation Specific Implementation Plans;**
- **Three events/ meetings** with main stakeholders related to the preparation of the PAP with Action Plan;
- **One public event** related to PAP with Action Plan;
- **Three events/ meetings to present** the DSIPs/ RSIPs under development.



Results to be achieved (3)

Result 3: Multiannual Investment Financing Plan adjusted

Capacities of the Ministry in charge for environmental protection as well as other institutions are improved in cost assessment, investment and financing planning.

Outputs:

- Revised and updated Multiannual Investment and Financing Plan (MIFP);
- One event on the MIFP.



Programme of Air Protection (PAP) of the Republic of Serbia with Action plan (1)

Overall articulation of the activities

- **Pilar I:** NEC (emissions control) – **activities** address **sources of air pollution** and deal with all issues related to Serbia's **future air pollutants emissions control** strategies until 2030 and beyond.
- **Pilar II:** AAQ (ambient air pollution) **activities** addresses all relevant issues related to **the ambient air quality in zones and agglomerations** in Serbia.
- **Pilar III:** PAP & AP – **activities** related to the preparation of the **Programme of Air Protection of the Republic of Serbia and Action Plan** build on the results from Pilar I and Pilar II.



Programme of Air Protection (PAP) of the Republic of Serbia with Action plan (2)

Scenario definitions

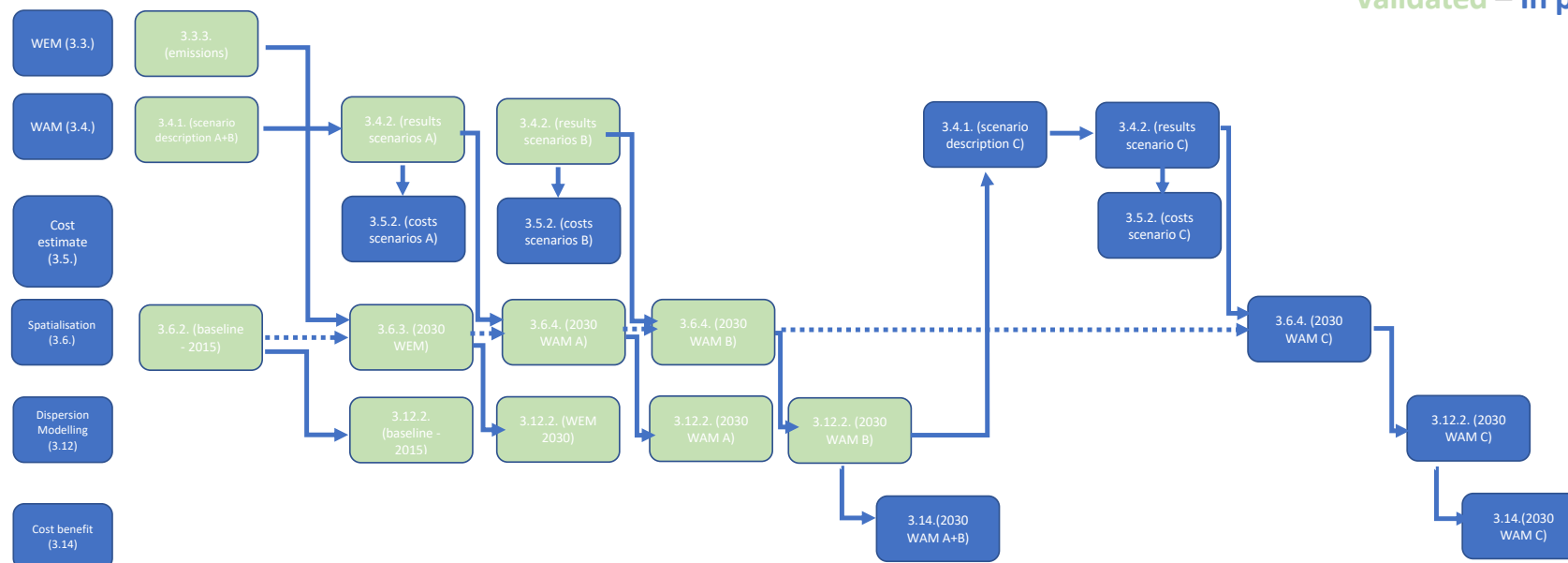
- **WEM** scenario: With Existing Measures;
- **WAM (With Additional Measures) scenario A:** EU policies and measures scenario (i.e. full implementation of all relevant EU directives and regulations not yet fully transposed and implemented);
- **WAM scenario B:** enhanced control EU Scenario (i.e. introducing national financial and fiscal policies and measures in key emission source categories (such as scraping and promotion schemes for passenger cars and household wood/ coal appliances));
- **WAM scenario C:** Full control scenario => to be defined based on projections from WAM scenarios A and B.
